






Chromatic Scale Range Requirements

Tuba		Quarter Note = 112 mm
Mallets	<i>You will play a three octave chromatic scale. The chromatic scale should be played in sixteenth notes, re-attacking the top note before descending. The chromatic scale will be the "C" chromatic scale, starting on the lowest "C" of the instrument.</i>	Quarter Note = 144 mm
